


Market Intelligence

- 3/19/2015: President Obama signed an executive order to set new goals for reducing the greenhouse gas emissions of federal agencies, which will cut emissions over the next decade by an average of 40 percent compared to 2008 levels, and to increase electricity use from renewable sources by 30 percent for federal agencies
- 3/15/2015: Suez Environnement Company S.A., the France-based wastewater treatment and waste management services company, could target Transpacific Industries, the Australia-based waste management business, for a takeover
- 3/5/2015: Google will contribute \$300 million as a tax-equity transaction to a \$750 million fund managed by SolarCity, the Californiabased solar energy systems provider, to support the installation of rooftop solar power systems
- 3/4/2015: SNC-Lavalin, the Canada-based infrastructure and environmental engineering and construction company, could receive interest from viable buyers due to its low share price
- 2/12/2015: Stericycle, the Illinois-based medical and biohazardous waste disposal services firm, remains acquisitive and could find a number of opportunities in South Korea
- 1/15/2015: ARCADIS, the Netherlands-based provider of infrastructure and environmental consultancy, design, engineering and management services, appoints John Jastrem as CEO for North American business


