- 3/2017 Ardagh Group (NYSE:ARD) is actively seeking further acquisitions in the U.S., Europe and Brazil


- 3/2017 Winpak (TSE:WPK) may potentially seek a strategic acquisition

- 1/2017 Huhtamäki (HLSE:HUH1V) to continue acquisitions with a focus on North America




Recent Lincoln International Transactions








LTM Relative Stock Price Performance
